What can the RETIRED OFFICERS group do for you?

For a modest annual subscription retired people who had previously been public sector employees can continue to be involved with the CPSU and to receive its services and benefits.

The RO's have a membership of about 350 and with this combined strength are involved in:

- lobbying the State and Federal Governments to maintain and improve benefits for retired public sector employees. Superannuation, taxation, and social services are just some of the issues the RO's tackle governments about.
- contributing to the running of the Union.
- running regular meetings with guest speakers focussing on relevant topics such as: superannuation; health; social security; financial planning; and, taxation.
- producing notices and newsletters for members.

Can I join?

Membership of the RO's is open to retirees who have previously been employed in the Victorian public sector and been union members while doing so. Membership also includes the participation of a spouse or partner.

CPSU federally is one of the largest unions in Australia with membership of about 200,000.

CPSU brings together state branches of the State Public Services Federation representing state government employees, and the Public Sector Union (of Commonwealth Government employees).
